Our Programs

We connect families in need to resources that help them thrive

Food Assistance

Eligible families receive fresh produce, meat, bread, and shelf-stable foods twice a month. We offer a choice pantry where pantry families select items at each station with volunteer assistance. We also offer personal care products, diapers, pet food, books, and more!

Share Closet

The Share Closet provides gently used clothing for men, women, teens and children. Small kitchen appliances, dishes and bedding are also available.

Utility Assistance

We provide up to \$200 in utility assistance every 365 days to families who need it. Families must live within one of our seven service zip codes and have a disconnect notice. Contact or visit the pantry for more details.



Problem Solving

We help families find resources and address barriers. Appointments can be scheduled by emailing us at support@hilliardfoodpantry.org or by visiting the pantry.

Benefits

We assist families with finding valuable resources and applying for benefits like SNAP, Medicaid, child care and cash assistance. Those interested in utilizing this service can visit the pantry during any open service times and ask to speak with a resource associate.



Holiday Assistance

The pantry provides holiday food options in November and holiday gifts for the children (ages 0-14 years) of pantry families in December. Sign-ups are held at the pantry during service hours starting the Tuesday after Thanksgiving.

Classes

We host a variety of classes each month, including nutrition-based education, financial literacy, cooking demos, and more!
